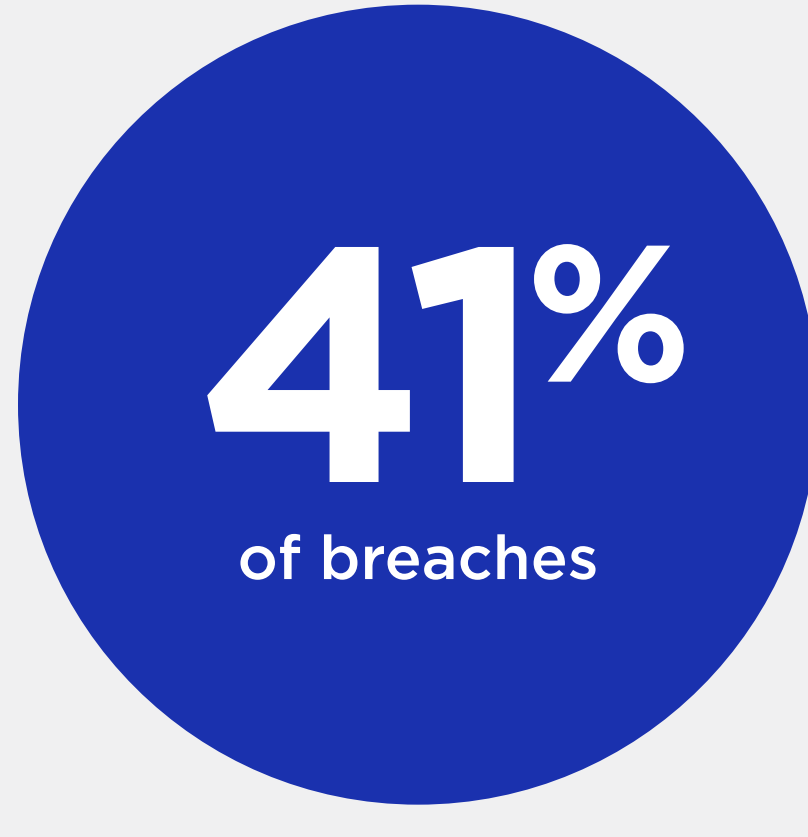


Employees expect to be able to bring their own device (BYOD), despite the risks posed to corporate security.

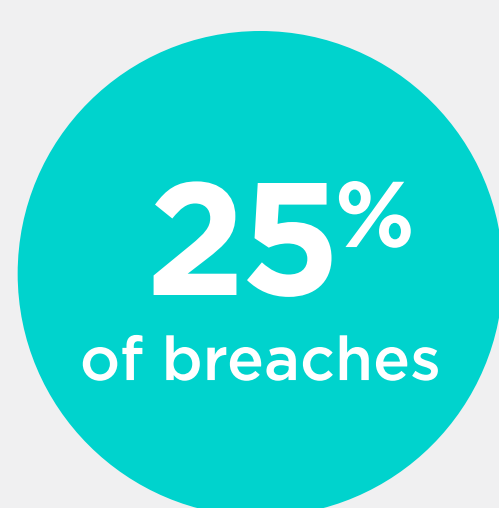


IT managers need to find ways to both facilitate BYOD + keep work and personal data on these devices separate and secure.

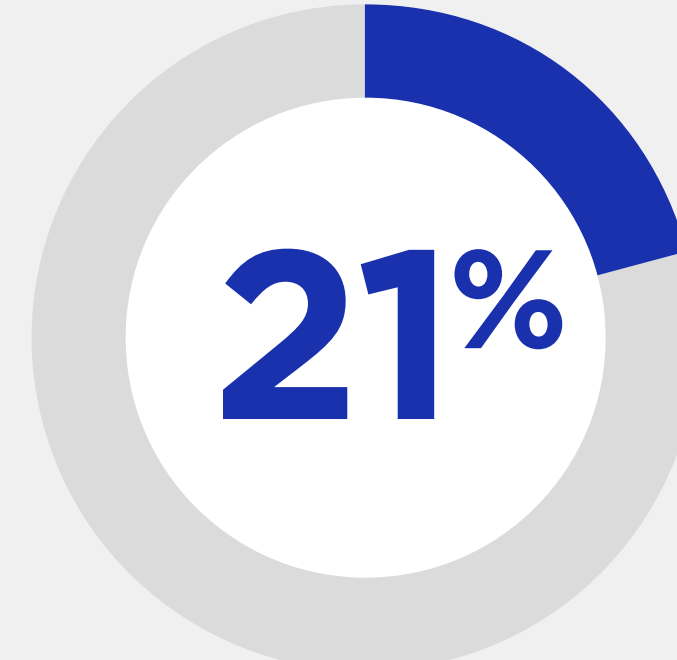
THE NUMBER OF DATA SECURITY BREACHES, AND THE IMPACT ON ORGANISATIONS, IS GROWING CONSTANTLY:



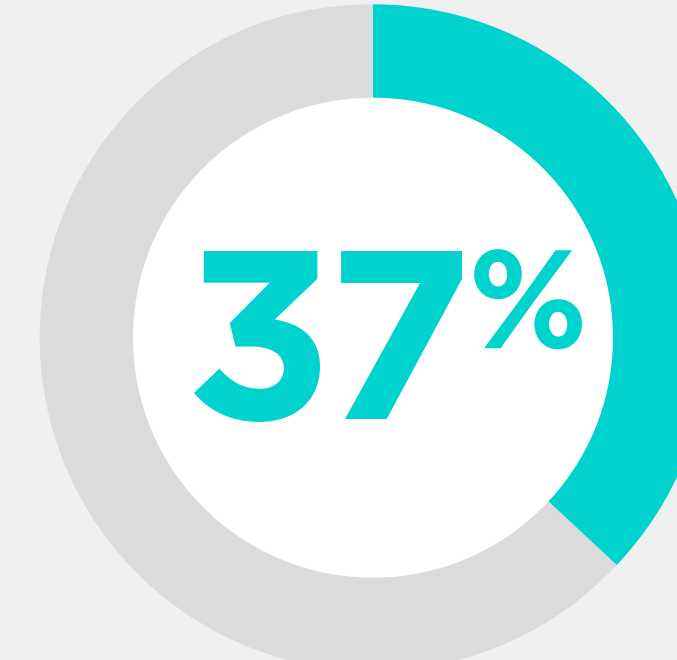

Device loss is the major cause of data theft (41% of breaches) ahead of those derived from **hacking and malware** (25% of breaches).²



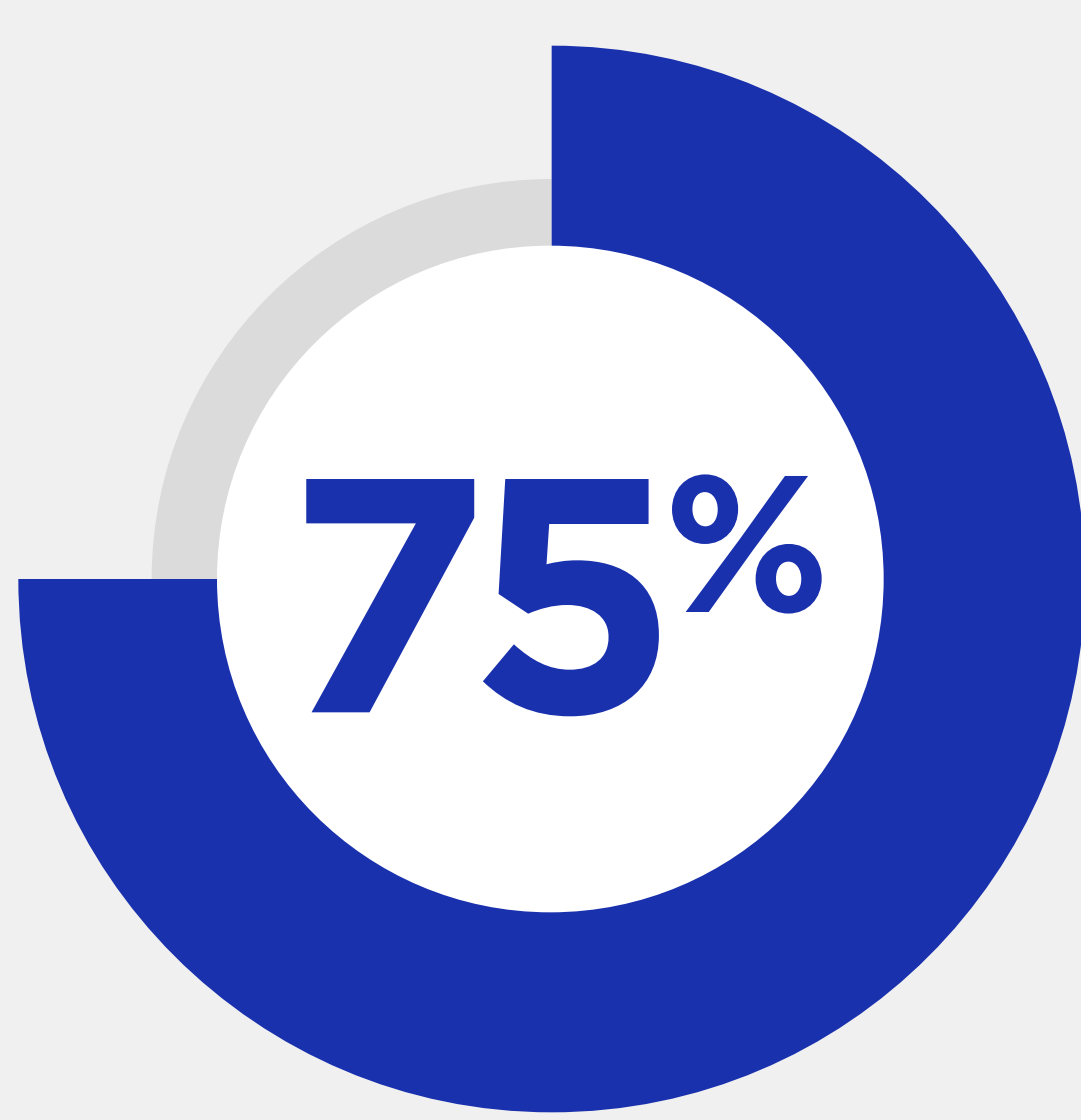

AUSTRALIA:
The Mandatory Notifiable Data Breach scheme means businesses can't keep silent on data breaches and hope for the best. From 22 February 2018, breaches must be reported to both the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner and people affected.



EUROPE:
The EU General Data Protection Regulation is getting tough on data security and all organisations that hold data on EU citizens have to comply — even those based outside of the EU.
