Considerations for healthcare providers

To retain a competitive advantage and ensure they are delivering the best care outcomes, providers need to focus on two key areas:

Empowering and enabling remote carers

Managing a team of remote carers, and coordinating home and community centre visits for people with a range of disabilities, as well as older Australians still living in their own homes, can be a major administrative burden, especially if the provider lacks the systems and tools to manage it effectively.

With the right technology in place, however, providers can more effectively manage field carers – ensuring the most appropriate carers are always allocated to the most appropriate jobs, the status of a job and a particular visit is accurately recorded, and that field service carers have the information they need at their fingertips. Yet empowering remote carers with connected devices also raises all-important security concerns. And today, with cyber-attacks on the rise, healthcare providers need to be particularly vigilant.

In the home-based and community care sector, which relies on keeping very accurate and in-depth information about individual consumers, data security is of particular concern.

For this reason, it's imperative that providers find a way to protect their data – for instance, by leveraging the new, robust security features in Microsoft 365, and investing in email and data security – such as is provided by Mimecast's security platform.
